Funding Your Private Healthcare

Our private healthcare can be accessed on either an insured basis or as a selfpay patient.

Insured Patients

If you have private medical insurance and want to choose The Horder Centre for your treatment, check with your insurer to confirm that you are covered for your treatment as well as any outpatient appointments and tests that may be required. We are recognised by the majority of medical insurance companies.

Self-Pay Patients

Patients can self-pay which means paying for their own procedures and services themselves, following an initial consultation. You will get a tailored, inclusive price for treatment based on your condition. Initial consultation and pre-op diagnostics are not included in the treatment package price.

If you would like to access our private healthcare on a self-pay basis, we offer a finance option which can help make the cost of your treatment more affordable.

Self-paying patients at Horder Healthcare are now able to take out loans that cover all fees, including the consultant, anaesthetist and hospital fees. The loan products include interest-free options up to 12 months, and interestbearing loans repayable in up to 60 months. Subject to approval. Do I Need a GP Referral?

In order to make an appointment to consult a specialist it is best practice to obtain a GP Referral. Once your referral arrives, you will be able to book an appointment with the consultant of your choice at a time that's convenient to you.

What Do I Need To Do if I Have Private Health Insurance?

If you have private medical insurance then you should also advise your GP that you will be going through your private health insurer and would like to choose Horder Healthcare for your private treatment.

You will need to confirm that you have the appropriate cover for the treatment you require with your insurance provider at each stage of treatment including the initial outpatient appointment. They will provide you with an authorisation number which you will need to provide to us before any treatment can take place.

Can I Self-Refer?

Yes, if you are self-paying and are not using medical insurance, you may self-refer for some services. To discuss whether the service you require is eligible for self-referral please contact the Private Patient Team on 01892 620931.

How Long Will My Cover Last?

As a self-pay patient your care does not stop once you have left the hospital. You can expect up to 120 days of guaranteed cover should you need further treatment related to your surgery or further advice on your condition.


The Horder Centre is designed to reflect the natural environment, creating a therapeutic atmosphere of calm, ensuring our patients have all the home comforts during their stay.
